1. $(p \rightarrow q) \vee (p \rightarrow r) \vee p$ is a tautology,
2. $(p \rightarrow q) \wedge (p \rightarrow r) \wedge p \equiv p \wedge q \wedge r$
3. $p \rightarrow (q \rightarrow r) \equiv (p \wedge q) \rightarrow r$
4. $p \vee (q \wedge r \wedge s) \equiv (p \vee q) \wedge (p \vee r) \wedge (p \vee s)$
5. $(p \wedge q \wedge r) \vee s \equiv (p \vee s) \wedge (q \vee s) \wedge (r \vee s)$
6. $p \leftrightarrow (q \wedge r) \equiv (p \rightarrow q) \wedge (p \rightarrow r) \wedge (\sim p \rightarrow \sim (q \wedge r))$
