# FIELD EXPERIENCES IN MIDDLE AND SECONDARY TEACHER PREPARATION UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA, MORRIS MORRIS, MN 56267

Field Experiences are an important aspect of teacher preparation. To best prepare yourself for an initial license and employment as an educator you need to have experience teaching at a variety of grade levels and in classrooms with students of different cultural backgrounds from the one in which you completed your K-12 schooling. For example, if you attended school in rural Minnesota, you probably encountered a mostly European culture. To prepare yourself for teaching a diverse population you would want to complete a field placement in another culture such as Chicago, El Paso, Twin Cities, overseas, etc. We suggest you visit the secondary education website: http://www.mrs.umn.edulacademic/education.html and the Global Student Teaching website: http://www.globalst.org for further information.

You will complete two major field experiences in your preparation as a middle and secondary school teacher: a fall practicum and student teaching.

## FALL PRACTICUM

The fall practicum is a part-time placement during fall semester and is completed in conjunction with education and methods classes. Success in the fall practicum is a factor in your continuation in the education program. During the fall practicum you will complete about 150 hours in a middle or secondary classroom. You will need to schedule a three hour block of time three days a week. If your placement school has a traditional schedule of a six or seven period day, you will be actively involved in two or three classes. If the school is organized on a block schedule you will work with one or two classes.

## SELECTING A LOCATION FOR THE FALL PRACTICUM

You may request a placement at an elementary, middle, junior, or senior high school for this practicum. Since you will be taking education and methods classes on Tuesdays and Thursdays, it may work best for you to schedule your practicum for mornings or afternoons on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, though alternate schedules can work.

In most cases you will request a placement in schools within a 60 mile radius of Morris, though you are not limited to that area. Some of the schools within the UMM area are listed below.

Discovery Middle and Jefferson High School in Alexandria, grades 7-9 and 10-12, 45 miles

Chokio-Alberta Secondary School in Chokio, grades 7-12, 25 miles

Benson Secondary School in Benson, grades 7-12, 25 miles

Clinton-Graceville Secondary School, grades 7-12, 37 miles

Herman-Norcross Secondary School in Herman, grades 7-12, 22 miles

Lac qui Parle Valley Secondary School between Appleton and Madison, gr. 7 -12, 37 miles

Minnewaska Secondary School between Starbuck and Glenwood, grades 7-12, 25 miles

Ortonville Secondary School in Ortonville, grades 7-12, 50 miles

West Central Secondary in Barrett, grades 7 -12, 22 miles

Wheaton Secondary School in Wheaton, grades 7-12, 35 miles

Willmar Junior and Senior High School in Willmar, grades 7-8 and 9-12, 57 miles
